Directions from the North West

Leave the M6 at Junction 11a and join the M6 Toll South. Exit the toll at Junction T3. At the roundabout turn LEFT towards Sutton Coldfield. At the next roundabout, take the first exit on to the A453 signposted Sutton Coldfield. Continue straight at the next set of traffic lights. At the second set of traffic lights (at the top of the hill) turn LEFT (South) onto the A5127 (Lichfield Road). At the end of the high street bear round to the right and continue down the hill and through the traffic lights (where the road bears left). Keep in the right hand lane and take the road round down the hill.

Directions from the North East

Leave the M1 at Junction 23A, keep left onto ramp towards A42/M42/The South West/Tamworth/Birmingham. The road name changes to the A42 and then to the M42 towards M42/The South West/Tamworth/Birmingham. Leave the M42 at Junction 9, and take the A446/NEC/(M6,M1)/Coventry (N and E). At the roundabout, take the FIFTH exit onto A446 (Lichfield Road). At the mini island take the 1st exit and pass the entrance to the Devere Belfry (on your right) continuing for four miles. At the next roundabout take the SECOND exit onto the A453 signposted Sutton Coldfield. Continue straight at the next set of traffic lights. At the second set of traffic lights (at the top of the hill) turn LEFT (South) onto the A5127 (Lichfield Road). At the end of the high street bear round to the right and continue down the hill and through the traffic lights (where the road bears left). Keep in the right hand lane and take the road round down the hill.

Directions from the South

From M1 or M42 join the M6 North. Leave the M6 at Junction 5. Keep left and follow the signs for A452/Birmingham (E)/Sutton Coldfield. At roundabout, take the THIRD exit onto A452 (Chester Road). Continue along the Chester Road to the junction with the A5127 (Birmingham Road) and turn RIGHT (McDonalds is on your left). Continue on this road into Sutton Town Centre. At the roundabout take the SECOND exit onto A5127 (Brassington Avenue). Keep right and go straight on the traffic lights. Keep in the right hand lane and take the road round down the hill.

Directions from Birmingham City Centre

Take the Aston Expressway (A38M) following signs to Sutton Coldfield. Continue along Gravelly Hill (A5127). At the roundabout, take the SECOND exit. The road bears to the right. At the second set of traffic lights (large junction with McDonalds on your right) go straight on. Continue on this road into Sutton Town Centre. At the roundabout take the SECOND exit onto A5127 (Brassington Avenue). Keep right and go straight on the traffic lights. Keep in the right hand lane and take the road round down the hill.

Directions by Train

From Birmingham, New Street Station take the Sutton Coldfield train (goes on to Four Oaks or Lichfield). On arrival cross the lines via the overhead passage and exit station at bottom of ramp, next to the Station pub. Walk down hill towards the town centre and cross over the road, turn left towards the lights. At the lights turn right into the pedestrian area. Just after Marks & Spencers, turn LEFT and proceed down South Parade (between Thomas Cook and Abbey National). Wrens Court is at the end of South Parade (the entrance being just after Nationwide Autocentre). Once in the courtyard, Haslimann Taylor can be found at the top right hand side.

SATNAV USERS PLEASE NOTE:

THE ENTRANCE TO WRENS COURT IS OFF SOUTH PARADE AND NOT ON LOWER QUEEN STREET. PLEASE THEREFORE ENTER SOUTH PARADE INTO YOUR SATNAV.

Parking

Wrens Court parking is limited and must be arranged prior to any visit - permits will be issued on arrival.
